Audience: Between 140 and 200 people interested in STEM education attend the conference, *primarily* K-12 science educators from Ventura, Santa Barbara, Los Angeles, and Kern counties. Individual workshops may have anywhere from five to 40 participants, depending on the topic. Please plan accordingly.

Complementary Conference Registration: *One* complimentary conference registration will be given to the *lead presenter* of each workshop, including breakfast and lunch. Co-presenters will need to register at the regular conference rate.
